2nd International Law & Technology Moot Court Competition in association with Cyberlaw University

On 28-29 August 2021, teams from all across the country and outside the country participated in the competition. The Inaugural address was delivered by *Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dipak Misra, Former Chief Justice Supreme Court of India*. He spoke on the importance of raising the legal education standard to international levels. He also congratulated GDGU for organising this Virtual Moot Court. Prof. (Dr.) Tabrez Ahmad, Vice-Chancellor & Dean School of Law, GD Goenka University in his address mentioned how moot court competitions are helpful for law students to understand the practical aspect of this branch of law. He also focused on Internationalisation of Indian legal education.

VC HPNLU*. After rigorous sessions in quarters, four teams proceeded to the semi-finals. Final session was judged by *Hon'ble Justice Manju Goel, Former Judge Delhi High Court, Hon'ble Justice S.N. Aggarwal Former Judge Delhi High Court, Prof. (Dr) KR Vurrakula VC NLU Ranchi, Alfredo M. Ronchi, General Secretary European Commission MEDICI Framework, Dr. Andril Paziuk Cybersecurity Enabling Environment Lead DAI, Ukraine, Prof. Sarah Jane Fox Professor University of East London, Dr. Paval Duggal, Advocate Supreme Court of India, Pawan Duggal & Associates and Chancellor of Cyber law University*. The eminent debating and the level of the negotiations by the teams took the judges by surprise. The esteemed judges chose the team from SVKM'S Pravin Gandhi college of Law as winner and RMLNLU as runner up. The event was successfully conducted and was widely covered by the media.



WEBINAR

Value of Quantitative & Qualitative Research Methods and Technology based Techniques of Participatory Research Methods

On 8 October 2021, GD Goenka UP Learn Academy organised an international webinar as a part of a series of live webinars for specialized learning during the crisis. Dr. Garry Fehr, resource person for the session in his erudite expression explained the concept of progressive curriculum within the philosophical and legal framework where the advantages and disadvantages of qualitative and quantitative research have been elaborated with critical note at length. He also emphasised upon the concept of participatory research explaining the need of technology based Participatory Action Research (PAR) and its utility model.

Theory and Practices of International Commercial Arbitration: A Legal Analysis

On 18 October 2021, GD Goenka UP Learn Academy organised an International Webinar on Theory and Practices of International Commercial Arbitration: A Legal Analysis, as a part of a series of live webinars for specialized learning during the crisis. The resource person, Mr. Badrinath Srinivasan in his seminal remarks, explained the world of international arbitration, explaining how and why arbitration as a mode of alternative dispute resolution works. He emphasised upon the legal and regulatory framework for international arbitration, as well as practical strategies to follow and pitfalls to avoid.

Role of In-House Counsel in an Infrastructure Business: Opportunities and Challenges

On 7 July 2021, a webinar was organized. Mr. Jaipuria (General Counsel-Indian Subcontinent of SUEZ, a French MNC) underscored the increase in demand for in-house counsels and helps the boardrooms take faster decisions. Different from the earlier segment of in-house lawyers who merely acted as the firm's interface with the law firm. The earlier in-house lawyers were also rarely involved in deal-making/live transactions. He emphasised on the critical contractual risks & the solutions to avoid them. The participants of the webinar found the same to be very insightful and informative.

International Human Rights Day

On 10 December 2021, a webinar on Reducing Inequalities and Advancing Human Rights in the Contemporary World was organized. The session was moderated by Dr. Ajit Kaushal. The guest was Mr. Riju Raj Jamwal, a noted advocate of the Supreme Court of India. He focused on principles of equality and non-discrimination which are at the heart of human rights. Issues of discrimination that affected the most vulnerable in societies especially women, indigenous, people of African descent, LGBTI people, migrants and people with disabilities, among others have been addressed and solutions were deliberated.

International Conference on Interdisciplinary Aspects of Law & Technology

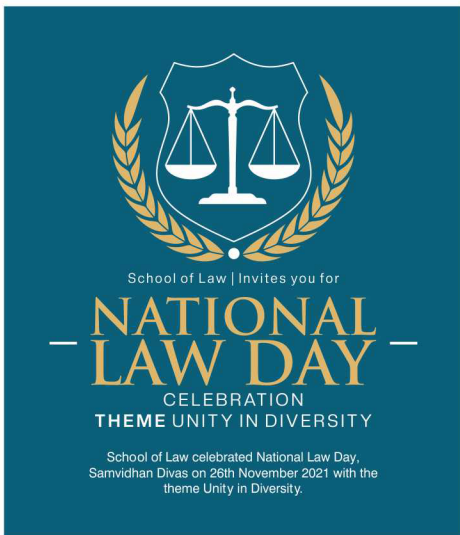

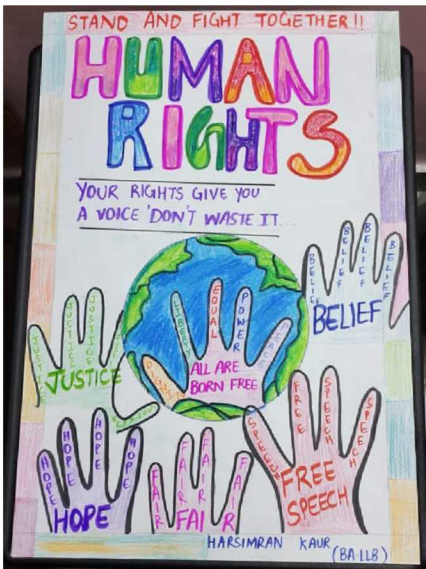
Impact of an Intellectual Property Rights cell in the University
